UNFCCC expressed its interest and engagement to contribute specifically to the topic in relation to local and indigenous knowledge, as the agency recently launched a new platform to create an open and inclusive space for knowledge sharing, fostering the capacity of engagement (including through technologies) and climate policy action for indigenous peoples. UNFCCC also expressed its interest in collaborating with the members of the Platform on the *non-economic losses* of climate change - a key topic at the COP-26 - and an entry point to explore ways in which climate-related events impact health, mobility, culture, and other societal issues.
