1. The 70th anniversary of the 1954 Hague Convention Logo

The 70th anniversary of the 1954 Hague Convention logo, shown below, is composed of the 1954 Convention and the text "In support of the 70th anniversary of the 19 Convention", which is placed at the top.

It is important to indicate as clearly as possible the context and the connection of a event with the anniversary by stating that "This [event / roundtable] is organized in c of the 70th anniversary of the 1954 Hague

in the Event of Armed Conflict" or "2024 marks the 70th anniversary of 1954 Hague Corfor the Protection of Cultural Property in the Event of Armed Conflict."

2. Use of the 70th anniversary of the 1954 Hague Convention log Commissions

A National Commission can use the 70th anniversary of the 1954 Hagus events and activities organised in 2024 and linked to the 70th anniversal
