- The Green school quality standard is the common basis of the pillar 1 of the GEP in reaching goal of transforming at least 50% of schools in each country into green schools by 2030.
- The Green school quality standard is designed to help harmonize the criteria of school accreditation schemes, ranging from school certification and labels, awards, school-based initiatives to projects demonstrating a commitment, to a line a Approach to Education for Sustainable Development (ESD), which integrate sustainability principles and climate action into four core dimensions: School governance, Facilities and operation, Teaching and learning, Community engagement.


