In 2012, Smit wrote a report for the European Parliament on the state of investigative journalism within the European Union member states and the role of investigative journalism in deterring fraud with EU funds. Smit is a member of the International Consortium of Investigative Journalists (ICIJ) and covered their #LuxLeaks investigation on tax evasion through Luxembourg for Dutch public TV. Smit is chairperson of the Organization of News Ombudsmen and standards and public editors (ONO), and vice-chair of the Global Investigative Journalism Network (GIJN).
